## How to get to Outdoor Adventure Camps and Castle Mountain Directions from Sydney

**NOTE:** Once you reach Wisemans Ferry, do not cross Wisemans Ferry car ferry. You need to cross **Webbs Creek** car ferry.

- Take the Old Northern Road to Wisemans Ferry. From Dural you will pass through Glenorie and Maroota. From Windsor you will travel through Pitt Town, Wisemans Ferry Road and Maroota.
- When you reach the base of the hill that descends into the township of Wiseman's Ferry *immediately* turn left – do this *before* the hotel.
- The turn is signposted for '**Webbs Creek Ferry**'. You will pass the police station on the left hand side. The ferry waiting bay is 300m downhill. Park on the left hand side of the road. (*Sign says Wait Here for Ferry*).
- Cross the Hawkesbury River on this ferry. (Ferry crossing takes about 5 minutes, is free and runs 24 hours per day)
- After disembarking from the ferry on the other side, drive about 100m. Take the first road on the left. This is signposted for Del Rio.
- After 200m there is an intersection with the bitumen continuing left and a dirt road to the right. Take the dirt road (this is Webbs Creek Road, and is signposted for Castle Mountain).
- Follow this road for 3km until you reach the Outdoor Adventure Camps sign and Castle Mountain entrance (large logs flanking the road with Castle Mountain carved into them).
- 400m past the entrance you will pass the manager's house (on right), and 50m after this the dirt road bends left to the suspension bridge. (**Coaches must set down here. Heavy vehicles please observe load limits on the bridge. All vehicles 10 km/h maximum**).
- For Camp Bunya do not cross bridge, continue straight ahead 600m to campsite
- For Castle Mountain (main site) and Little River, cross the suspension bridge and follow the dirt road into the Castle Mountain campsite (400m).
- The manager's office is located under the wooden Chalet, which is the first building after passing the main hall. (Staff may also be located in the hut behind the Chalet, which can be found by ascending the stairs above the manager's office).
- For access to the Little River campsite, follow the road past the Chalet for 100m until you reach the sign 'Little River'. Turn left here and follow the dirt road for 2km.

- Webb's Creek Ferry is open 24 hours except the first Tuesday of each month when it is closed for maintenance between 9:30 am and 11:30 am.
- Please allow an extra 30 mins in travel time to Castle Mountain for ferry delays.
